


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WK2 Recovery Point

Install Instructions



REF QTY DESCRIPTION

- A 1 Recovery Point (E-Coat + Powder Coat)
- **B** 1 Middle Mounting Plate (E-Coat)
- **C** 1 Top Mounting Plate (E-Coat)
- **D** 2 M10 x 90mm 10.9 Bolts (Zinc)
- **E** 1 M10 x 65mm 10.9 Bolts (Zinc)
- **F** 4 M10 Wedge-Lock Extended Washers (Zinc Flake)
- **G** 1 M10 CL10 Nut (Zinc)

REQUIRED TOOLS

Ratchet 21mm Socket 16mm Socket 16mm Wrench OPTIONAL - 13mm Socket
POSSIBLE - 30mm Socket
POSSIBLE - 18mm Socket
POSSIBLE - Dremel Cutting Tool

NOTES

- Do not over-tighten fasteners.

- PROPER INSTALLATION IS ESSENTIAL TO THE PERFORMANCE OF THIS PRODUCT.
- ONLY INSTALL THIS PRODUCT ON A 2011-2018 JEEP GRAND CHEROKEE.
- ONLY USE THE PROVIDED HARDWARE FOR INSTALLATION.
- DO NOT MODIFY THE STRUCTURE OF THIS PRODUCT IN ANY WAY.
- CHECK PRODUCT REGULARLY FOR DAMAGE. REPLACE IMMEDIATELY AT FIRST SIGN OF DAMAGE.
- CHECK FASTENER TIGHTNESS REGULARLY AND TIGHTEN IF REQUIRED.

Remove Lower Fascia.

1. Remove the lower fascia and set aside. Refer to the Owners Manual for basic instructions.

NOTE

RIGHT SIDE INSTALLATION (Go To Step 2) **LEFT SIDE INSTALLATION** (Go To Step 4)

Right & Left sides are determined while sitting in the vehicle.

Right Side Installation

Remove OEM Screw-In Hook Threaded Tube.

1. Remove 21mm bolt on back of bracket. With the bolt removed, slide the threaded tube out of the bracket. You will now have access to the frame mounting bolts.



NOTE

This step is only required on export models without OEM Tow Hooks. 2013+ WK2s have a different bracket, (see Step 3).

Right Side Installation

Remove OEM Screw-In Hook Bracket.

1. Remove (2) M10 bolts holding bracket to frame.

The OEM Screw-In Hook Bracket can now be removed.




NOTE

This step is only required on export models without OEM Tow Hooks. 2011-2012 WK2s have a different bracket, (see Step 2).



Remove OEM Tow Hook.

- 1. Unbolt (2) M10 bolts [**E in side diagram**] holding front of Tow Hook to vehicle.
- 2. Unbolt 30mm Nut on backside [**F in side diagram**] and slide Tow Hook forward out of bracket.



NOTE

This step is only required for WK2s with OEM Tow Hooks. This diagram is taken from Mopar's official installation instructions.


Remove OEM Tow Hook Bracket.

1. Unbolt (2) M10 bolts [**C** in side diagram] holding OEM Tow Hook bracket to vehicle.

The OEM Tow Hook Bracket can now be removed.

NOTE

This step is only required for WK2s with OEM Tow Hooks. This diagram is taken from Mopar's official installation instructions.





Prepare lower fascia.

- 1. Remove the 'pop-out' plastic parts by pushing on them from behind to reveal access holes.
- 2. If you don't have 'pop-out' plastic parts, you'll need to cut access holes in the lower fascia using a dremel or similar tool.



Cutting is required on all Summit, High Altitude, export 75th Anniversary, and export 2017 models without OEM Tow Hooks. These models do not provide holes in the lower fascia for access to the points.





Prepare for installation.

- Stack the Top Mounting Plate [C] and Middle Mounting Plate [B] on top of the Recovery Point [A].
- 2. Apply Anti-Seize to the threads on all bolts.

NOTE

The Recovery Point [A] should angle towards the centre of the vehicle. All holes should align and the edges of the mounting plates should also align. Make sure all mounting surfaces are clean and free from grease or dirt.

Install Strengthening Bolt.

 Slip (1) M10 Wedge-Lock Washer [F] onto (1) M10 x 65mm Bolt [E] and slip it down through the forward most hole on the Middle Mounting Plate [B] and Recovery Point [A]. Slip (1) M10 Wedge-Lock Washer [F] onto the end of the bolt and attach (1) M10 CL10 Nut [G]. Finger tighten.

NOTE

Installing the Strengthening Bolt now, helps hold the stack together during installation and avoids bumper interference installation issues on USA models.





Bolt WK2 Recovery Point to chassis.

- Slip (1) M10 Wedge-Lock Extended Washer [F] onto (1) M10 x 90mm Bolt [D]. Slip the Bolt & Washer combo through the rear most hole in the stack, (Recovery Point [A] and mounting plates, from Step 6). Hold the stack up to the chassis, align the mounting holes and thread the rear bolt into the chassis.
- 2. Slip (1) M10 Wedge-Lock Extended Washer [**F**] onto (1) M10 x 90mm Bolt [**D**]. Slip the Bolt & Washer combo through the remaining mounting hole and thread into the chassis.



NOTES

It can be difficult to access the rear mounting bolt if you have our WK2 Sump Protection Plate installed. This can be especially difficult on the left side due to the location of the windshield washer bottle. By unbolting the wheel well liner from the side of the WK2 Sump Protection Plate (or OEM 'Belly Pan') you can reach from behind to more easily access the rear mounting bolt.



Tighten Bolts.

- 1. Tighten the (2) chassis mounting bolts.
- 2. Tighten the strengthening bolt.



NOTE

Recommended M10 Bolt Torque = 90Nm (Dry) or 74Nm (Anti-Seize)

Re-install Lower Fascia.

1. Re-install the lower fascia. Refer to the Owners Manual for basic instructions.

WK2 Recovery Point is now fully installed.

MAINTENANCE

FASTENERS

• Check fastener tightness regularly and tighten if required. We recommend checking fasteners after every large off-road trip.

CORROSION PROTECTION

- After an off-road trip; rinse all mud, sand or debris off the product.
- After driving in salt water; rinse product thoroughly with fresh water.

EXTRA CARE

- If you're planning to drive in a salty environment; spray fasteners with WD40 or an equivalent.
- If you're planning to drive in a salty environment; spray product with Lanolin or an equivalent.
- Spray deep scratches (before they rust) with touch up paint to help inhibit corrosion.
